Past simple

Past simple passive (was/ were +p.p.)

Past continuous (was/ were + verb(ing)) (The students were playing in the garden)

Past continuous passive: (was/ were + being + p.p.) : (The hotel **was being renovated** when it got fired.

Past perfect: Had +p.p. (she **had bought** a car before she graduated.)

Past perfect passive: had + been + p.p. (The library **had been converted into** to a café before he became the mayor.)

Used to : to express past habits

Used to + simple verb (He used to walk to work. I used to drink coffee for breakfast.)/ I **didn't use to have** breakfast before school.
