Grammar

Habits

Past habits:

Used to + infinitive without to (*They used to walk to school./ I used to drink coffee for breakfast./ I used to like spicy food more.*)

Didn't use to + infinitive without to : *The students didn't use to wear uniforms at school.*

Would + infinitive without to: (*They would walk to school.*)

Annoying habit: *present continuous with "always" : My friend is always calling me late at night./ Our neighbours are always having loud parties on the weekend*

Present habits

Get used to + verb (ing) : *I should get used to driving on the left.*

To be used to + verb (ing) : *I am used to drinking coffee for breakfast./ She is used to getting up early.*
